YORK COUNTY TREASURER BARBARA BAIR KICKS-OFF 2023 CAMPAIGN

York, PA – York County Treasurer



Barbara L. Bair, 58, formally announced today, that she is seeking re-election as York County Treasurer, a post she has held since

2000. The occasion also marks her 39th wedding anniversary to husband, Robert A. Bair. The Republican couple was married on President Lincoln's birthday February 12, 1984.

"It is a great honor to serve the citizens of York County," Bair said. "I have been able to develop a great staff that shares my vision for hard work with positive customer friendly service to the public in this very important County fiscal office."

"My continual focus is to keep bottom-line costs low for the taxpayers of York County and I have worked very hard to develop practical and beneficial relationships with the county commissioners, my fellow row officers and the many county departments that serve our community so very well," said Bair.

Despite the difficulties of the pandemic, voters need to know that their County Treasurer worked each and every day in the office. "The only exception was for the graveside service of my father, Bruce Stein, who succumbed to Covid-19 at age 86 in October 2020. My father's work ethic guides me every day since taking the oath of office," Treasurer Bair said. Sadly, Beverly Stein, her mother passed away at age 87, on

February 11th just before today's campaign announcement.

"I am constantly reminded that serving as County Treasurer is an awesome responsibility, one of public trust and accountability. I really enjoy my job and I take it very seriously. No pandemic, no staff shortages, nothing could keep me from fulfilling my responsibilities of collecting over \$545 million dollars in 2020," says Treasurer Bair.

Since taking office in 2000, Bair has accurately accounted for over \$10 Billion dollars in her fiduciary role as York County Treasurer.

Bair says her office continually leads the Commonwealth in the sale of lifetime dog licenses, 3,726 in 2022. We processed 21,137 annual dog licenses in 2022 as an agent for the state. For our hunting friends, we issued 27,090 antlerless deer licenses. We enjoy providing this constituent service for the people of York County.

A strong advocate for the diversification of county pension investments, Bair says, "We have some of the best advisors. Our pension returns are among the top performers of municipal plans in the Commonwealth," of which Bair is a voting member of the York County Retirement Board.

"I recognize that rank and file workers are not always highly compensated. However, I believe that those who stick with county government service have the peace of mind knowing that their pension will be secure when they retire. York County Taxpayers can take comfort knowing that their public funds are invested wisely," Treasurer Bair said.

Bair says we've assisted a number of municipalities and school districts with their real estate tax collections. When vacancies occur and assistance is requested, my office is there to help. We've saved taxing authorities

money and improved the quality of service to their constituents.

"I thank the voters for their continued confidence in me and the privilege of public service," says Bair, "I am always looking for innovative solutions that increase services to our citizens and contribute to the County's overall financial health."

Bair serves as a member of the York County Retirement Board, York County Depository Board, and York County Finance Committee. She is Treasurer of the Red Lion Grange No. 1781, President of the Susquehanna Senior Center Board, and is a lifetime member and Treasurer of the York County Conservation Society. She serves as a member and Treasurer of the Pennsylvania State Association of Elected County Officials (PSAECO). She is past President (2021-22) of the PA County Treasurers' Association.
